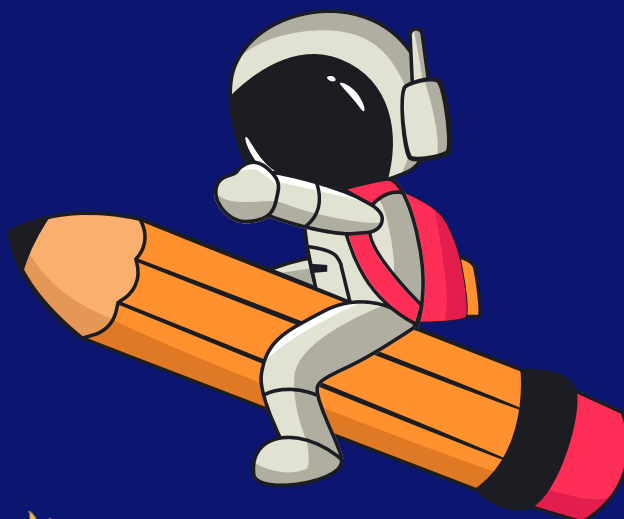

JELLYFISH

Materials: paper bowl, tissue paper, colourful paper, string, scissors, glue, tape, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Start by decorating your paper bowl to form the body of the jellyfish. You could paint or colour the jellyfish or make a design using colourful paper.
- Next, attach a piece of string to the top of the bowl. You could either make a hole in the paper bowl, thread the string through, and tie a knot to hold it in place, or you could tape the string to the top of the bowl.
- Finally, cut some strips of tissue paper and tape them to the underneath of the bowl to make jellyfish tentacles.



VOLCANO

Materials: paper plate, paper cup, tissue paper, colourful paper, scissors, glue, tape, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Turn the paper cup upside down, and tape or glue it to the middle of the paper plate to form a volcano.
- Once the volcano is secure, decorate the rest of the paper plate as the bottom of the volcano. You could add some grass using tissue paper, or you could colour it in with green, or even add some flowers.
- Finally, decorate your volcano with reds, yellows, and oranges to look like lava and fire. For this you could use tissue paper, or colourful paper, or any crafting materials you might have on hand. You could even add some cotton wool to the top of the volcano for smoke.



ICE-CREAM

Materials: lollipop sticks, colourful paper, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Create a design for your ice-creams by cutting out shapes using colourful paper. You could try to recreate one of your favourite ice-creams, or you could invent your own with all your favourite toppings and flavours.
- Once you're happy with your design, tape or stick it to the lollipop stick. Now you're ready to run your own ice-cream stall!



SLOTH

Materials: paper plates, colourful paper, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Start by folding and cutting a paper plate in half. Use one half for the body of the sloth and cut the other half of the paper plate into two arms.
- Then, draw and cut out a sloth face using either another paper plate or some paper. Maybe your sloth is sleepy, or perhaps they are a happy sloth!
- Assemble your sloth by sticking the arms and head onto the body. You could add some extra decoration by colouring lots of short lines to look like the sloth's fur.
- Cut out a branch shape using paper or card and then add some green leaves or maybe even some vines. Finish by sticking the sloth's arms to the branch, so that it looks like it is hanging from a tree!

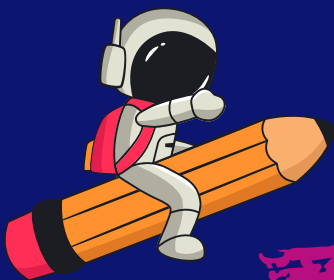


STAR SCANNER

Materials: mini cereal box, lollipop stick, pom poms, colourful paper, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- To begin with, cover your mini cereal box in paper. It might help to cover it as if you are wrapping up a present.
- Next, tape a lollipop stick to the back of the box, so that it sticks out the top, and glue a pom pom to the end of the stick. This will act as your sensor.
- Finally, decorate your star scanner with buttons and a screen, and then you're ready to search for some stars!
