

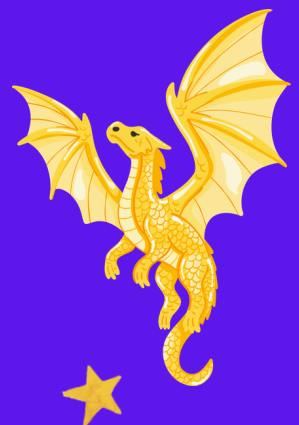

CRAFT GUIDE

FOR LITTLE PEOPLE AND THEIR
GROWN UPS



MAGIC FLOWERS

Materials: cupcake cases, paper straws, pom poms, colourful paper, scissors, glue/tape, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Start by cutting some cupcake cases into flower shapes. You could have rounded or spiky petals, or any shape you like. Once you are happy with your petals, stick the cases together in layers to form a flower.
- If you have pom poms, you could glue them to the middle of the flower, or you could add some other decorations using any crafting materials you may have.
- Finally, tape the flower heads to a paper straw to complete the flower.



BINOCULARS

Materials: cardboard tubes, colourful paper, string, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Cover two cardboard tubes with colourful paper. You could also paint them or decorate them with stickers. Make sure to leave a space in your design if you are using masking tape or washi tape instead of clear, see-through tape.
- Once you are happy with the design of your binoculars, tape the two cardboard tubes together.
- If you'd like to wear your binoculars around your neck, cut a length of string and tape each end to the inside of the tubes, so that it hangs in a loop.



PIGS

Materials: colourful paper or card, pipe cleaners, scissors, glue, tape, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- To begin with, cut a strip of paper and roll it into a tube, sticking it together with either glue or tape so that it holds.
- Decorate your pig by drawing on a face with a snout, eyes, ears, and mouth.
- Finally, curl a pipe cleaner around your finger and tape it to the back of the pig to form a curly pig's tail.

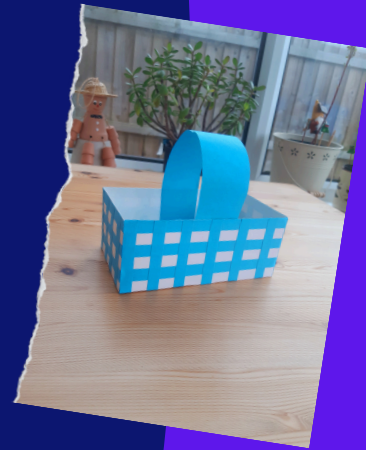


PICNIC BASKETS

Materials: box, colourful paper, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- Using a spare box, cut off the lid or one of the sides so that you have an open-ended box.
- Next, cut a strip of paper or card, and tape it to either side of the box, forming a handle that curves over the top of the picnic basket.
- Decorate your picnic basket in any design you like! You could cut some strips of paper and stick them on to the outside of the basket in a lattice pattern, or you could draw some of your own designs.



BEANSTALKS

Materials: cardboard tube, cotton wool, colourful paper, glue, tape, scissors, crayons/pens/paint.

Instructions:

- To begin with, cover a cardboard tube in green paper. You could also colour or paint it instead.
- Then, glue or tape cotton wool to the top of the tube to form some clouds.
- Finally, draw and cut out some leaves to stick to the cardboard tube (you'll need these to climb your beanstalk and reach the giant's house!)
