CRAFT GUIDE

FOR LITTLE PEOPLE AND THEIR
GROWN UPS

CAMPSITES

Materials: card, colourful paper, tissue paper, tape/glue, scissors, pens/crayons/paint.

Instructions:

- Using a piece of card as a base, start by decorating the ground of your campsite. For example, you could make a grass section and a lake section using materials such as colourful paper, paint, or crayons.
- Next, add any features you might like to your campsite. You could fold a piece of colourful paper in half and stick it down to make a tent, or you could make a campfire from tissue paper.



TOOLBOXES

Materials: empty box, colourful paper, card, lollipop sticks, tape/glue, scissors, pens/crayons/paint.

Instructions:

- Start by cutting off the lid of an empty box for an open-top toolbox. Next, cut a thin strip of card and glue or tape it to each side of the box for the handle.
- Decorate your toolbox with any crafting materials you have to hand.
- If you'd like to make some tools for your toolbox, you could draw some and cut them out, or print off some templates.



CATS AND DOGS

Materials: paper cups, colourful paper, tape/glue, scissors, pens/crayons/paint.

Instructions:

- To make your cat and dog puppets, you could either draw and cut out features to glue onto the paper cup, or you could just draw straight onto the cup.
- You could add different features for your cat or dog, including a nose, some eyes, ears, tails, and whiskers.



PAPER KITES

Materials: colourful paper, card, paper straws, pipe cleaners, string/ribbon, tape/glue, scissors, pens/crayons/paint.

Instructions:

- Start by drawing a kite shape onto a piece of card and cutting it out. You could print off a template to help with this.
- On one side of the kite, cut and glue some paper straws in a cross shape to give the kite stability.
- Next, tape a pipe cleaner to the bottom of the kite. You could tie some ribbons or pieces of string onto the pipe cleaner for extra decoration.
- Finally, decorate your kite using any crafting materials you have!



TENNIS RACQUETS

Materials: paper plates, card, paper straws, scissors, tape/glue, pens/crayons/paint.

Instructions:

- To begin with, draw and cut out an oval shape onto a paper plate to form the body of the racquet.
- Next, draw and cut out a long handle shape using a piece of card and tape it to the bottom of the paper plate. It may help to tape or glue a paper straw to the back of the handle to give it some stability.
- Finally, decorate your tennis racquet!
