



This is the Easy Read/ Visual Story for Clown WIP as part of Clown Hour (and a bit!).

11:50am, Saturday 21st October 2023.




There is one performer in this physical comedy show, Natalie Patuzzo



I am Natalie, but in the show I go by Nat. I play a clown version of myself.


The story



Nat enters swimming through the audience onto the stage, searching for something. She finds a toilet chain and pulls it, finding herself in the room with the audience.



Nat welcomes everyone to this very urgent meeting she has called and announces that she herself had to cut short a loch ness monster hunting expedition to be here today.



Nat wants to tell the audience about her organisation and invites an audience member on stage to join her and be a stand for her flipchart.



In the presentation she tells us about her organisation: the NOT FAKE, which stands for Newark-On-Trent Finding All Kryptids (cryptids) Ever.



Nat explains to the audience that cryptids are very real creatures that scientists and the government are hiding from us.

Nat wants to reveal secret information to the audience, but decides to initiate them






into the organisation first so that she can trust them.





Nat invites another audience member on stage who she calls 'Linda'. Linda is one of the few existing members of the NOT FAKE in attendance before today. Linda must lead the rest of the audience in an initiation promise.

Nat then teaches the audience a special breathing technique to connect her and the audience as a community.



Now that Nat trusts the audience she feels she can reveal the top secret information that a yeti has been spotted in a local shop.




Nat wants the audience to help her hunt for the yeti, so she wants to give an example of what to look for when hunting for a yeti. She gives Linda a checklist to help her, and invites an audience member on stage to be an example yeti.



Linda reads out the yeti checklist:

- √ Hairy
- ✓ Big feet
- √ Cool
- ✓ Yeti noises
- √ Yeti smell

With each check, Nat adds an element to the audience member to create her yeti.



Nat believes she has created such a realistic yeti that she thinks it might be real. She asks some research questions, but realising that she is falling in love finally asks the yeti what their ideal first date is.



Nat wants to show the yeti her ideal first date which it turns out is to dance together to The Time Of My Life from Dirty Dancing.



Nat is so excited and in love that she proposes to the yeti! But what will the yeti say...?
