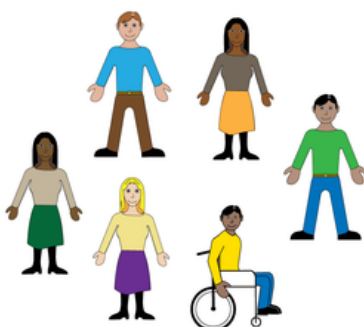
You are visiting a theatre called Nottingham Playhouse.



In the entrance you will see our Box Office.

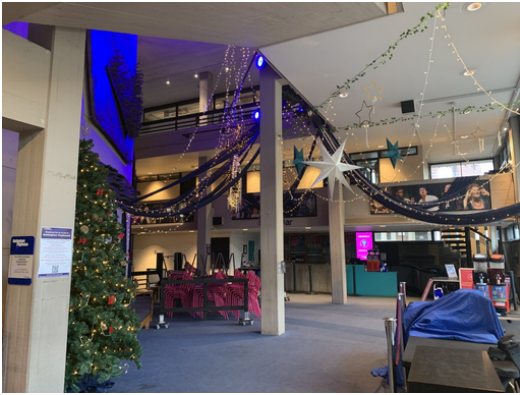


This is where people buy or collect tickets.

The foyer and chill-out space



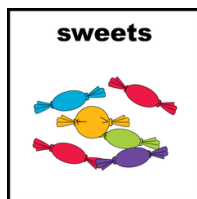
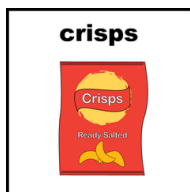
People wait to see the show in the foyers.

This is what the bars look like.

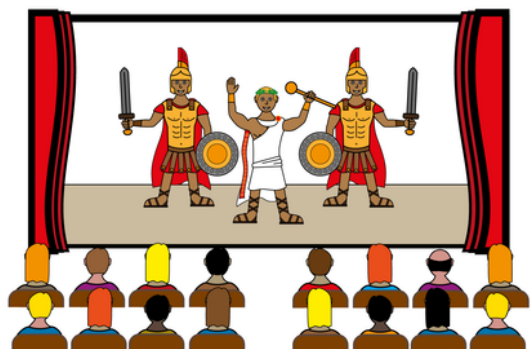
The Main Stage



The auditorium is where you will sit to watch The Market Deeping Model Railway Club. The Customer Experience Team will help you find your seat.



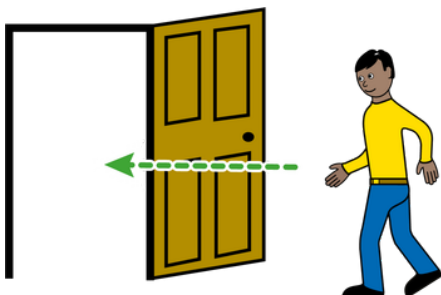
This is what the stage will look like.

The Story



Linda, Graham's wife and deputy, is setting up a club meeting. The members of The Market Deeping Model Railway Club enter celebrating, after winning a railway model competition. They talk proudly and about their plans for future railway models.



Graham, the chairman, becomes uncomfortable when the meeting's aims changes and members suggest continuing the meeting downstairs in the pub below them.



Graham is in the attic at home. Linda becomes frustrated because it is late. Linda is worried as they could get kicked out from The Market Deeping Model Railways Club's building and Graham has not told the members.



It is now Christmas. Ken is at the Club and is playing music. Ken reflects on coming close to winning a railway model competition. George arrives distressed as he accidentally takes the wrong medication.



The Club has a meeting and they discuss politics even though it is a banned topic. Chris and Neil argue and Graham raises his voice and asks Chris to leave the room. Linda arrives with pizza and she dances to music.



The Club members work on their models. Jerry arrives in a cheerful mood. Jordan, a recent university graduate, visits the Club for the first time. Members are impressed by his knowledge and modelling skills.



Jerry becomes frustrated by technical difficulties with a model. It is revealed he has accidentally taken drugs. Linda plays music again, which helps encourage Jordan to join the Club. Ken is close to finishing his model.



At the annual model railway show, Ken and Jordan set up their exhibition layout, called the Woodcroft.



In the night, a group of teenagers vandalise and destroy the exhibition display. The Club members gather to see the damage. Everyone is upset. Chris is very angry. George is taken to hospital as he is so shocked.



Journalist reporters want to interview the club about the vandalism. George is annoyed with Chris's behaviour and uses strong language towards him. Jordan tells the group that news of the vandalism has become very popular on social media.



The Club sorts through donations from the public. No one has heard from Ken. Graham receives a phone call from the police as the vandals have been found. The Club then receives an unexpected, big money donation from rockstar, Rod Stewart.



Linda feels upset and lonely within her marriage. She and Graham discuss their relationship and personal passions. Neil suddenly arrives with sad news about George.



The Club returns after George's funeral and shares memories of him. Graham finally tells everyone that they are being evicted. Ken announces he is leaving the club. Ken and Chris argue and get into a physical fight.



Ken speaks about his military experiences. He becomes emotional and leaves. Neil accuses Chris of racism, leading Chris to leave as well.



The remaining Club members discuss why the vandalism happened and the importance of supporting one another.
